

# Notes to Applicant

## for Registration as a Grade G Contractor

RG 11

### NOTE 1 – SECTION A

#### Name of Applicant

Applicant shall state the exact name as it appears on the **Business Registration Card** as the Certificate of Registration will be issued on that name.

### NOTE 2 – SECTION B

#### Classes of Works applying for

Applicant shall apply for a Class of Works in which it is currently operating or intends to operate provided it meets the Eligibility requirements for that Class of Works.

Applicant may apply for more than one Class of Works provided it meets the requirements for registration in the corresponding Classes. However, he should provide a **Breakdown of Turnover**.

### NOTE 3 – SECTION D

#### Turnover

A Grade G Contractor is allowed to undertake works up to Rs 10M.

To be eligible for Grade G, an applicant shall demonstrate an Average Turnover as indicated in the Table below:

Class of Works	Average Turnover (Last 5 years) Rs M
Building Construction Works	4
Civil Engineering Construction Works	4
Mechanical Works (including Plumbing Works)	1.2
Electrical Works	1.8

### NOTE 3 – SECTION D

#### Highest Value Project

To be eligible for Grade G, an applicant should have during the last 10 years completed at least one project equivalent to the value as indicated in the Table below:

Class of Works	Highest Value Project (Last 10 years) Rs M
Building Construction Works	7.5
Civil Engineering Construction Works	7.5
Mechanical Works (including Plumbing Works)	1.2
Electrical Works	1.8
