

# Notes to Applicant

## for Registration as a Joint Venture Contractor

RG9

### NOTE 1 - SECTION A

#### **Name of Joint Venture**

Applicant shall state the name of the Joint Venture entity as per the agreement between the parties as the Certificate of Registration will be issued on that name.

#### **Last Registration Reference issued by CIDB**

If the Joint Venture entity had previously been granted Registration by CIDB, it shall state that Registration Reference.

### NOTE 2 - SECTION B

#### **Classes of Works applying**

Applicant shall apply for a Class of Works in which it intends to operate.

#### **Grade applying for**

Grading allows a Contractor to undertake works up to the thresholds indicated in **Table 1** below:

Grade	Threshold	Grade	Threshold
A	Up to any amount above Rs 200M	E	Up to Rs 20M
B	Up to Rs 200M	F	Up to Rs 10M
C	Up to Rs 100M	G	Up to Rs 4M
D	Up to Rs 50M	H	Up to Rs 1.5M

Applicant shall however apply for a Grade for which it meets the main **Eligibility** requirements as indicated in **Table 2 & Table 3** below:

**Average Turnover<sup>1</sup>** is the cumulative Total Turnover (exclusive of VAT) for construction works over the last 5 years divided by 5.

For Firm in existence for less than 5 years, the average turnover shall be the total turnover since its existence divided by the number of years in operation.

**Highest Value Project<sup>2</sup>** – Applicant should have during the last 10 years undertaken at least one project equivalent to the value corresponding to the Grade applying for, as indicated in **Table 2** and **Table 3** respectively.

Example for Eligibility in Building Construction Works:

An applicant for Grade C shall satisfy:-

1. An Average Turnover of Rs 50M; and
2. One Highest Value Project of Rs 75M.

#### **Areas of Specialisation applying for**

There are several Areas of Specialisation under each of the 4 Classes of Works. The details of the Areas of Specialisation are indicated in the Third Schedule of the CIDB Act available at <http://cidb.gov.mu>

Over and above the grading of a Contractor in a Specific Class of Works, a Contractor can also be registered as a Specialist Contractor in one or more Areas of Specialisation within any of the 4 Classes of Works as prescribed in the Third Schedule of the CIDB Act. However to be eligible for consideration as a Specialist Contractor, one shall demonstrate that it has the capabilities in terms of Resources and Experience to undertake Works in that Area of Specialisation.

### NOTE 3 - SECTION C

#### **Details of Project**

Applicant shall provide details of the Project which it intends to undertake.

“Brief Description of project” shall include the percentage of work Applicant intends to subcontract and the Contract Value of Works to be subcontracted.
