

## <u>COMMUNIQUÉ</u>

## CONTRACTORS AND CONSULTANTS OPERATING WITHOUT CIDB REGISTRATION

The Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) has been apprised that a few Contractors and Consultants are operating in the Construction Industry without being duly registered under the provisions of the CIDB Act.

Section (19) of the CIDB Act provides that "No person shall offer his services as a Consultant or as a Contractor, unless he is registered under the Act."

Where a Contractor or Consultant contravenes the above provision, he may be liable to a fine not exceeding Rs 100,000 and to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 2 years.

The CIDB hereby invites all Contractors and Consultants who are operating without a Certificate of Registration, to call at this Office at the earliest to apply for registration.

## Please note that:

<u>Contractors</u> undertaking works of Contract Value up to Rs 1 million are <u>exempted</u> from registration, and

Consultants operating as freelance individuals in their Own Name, and not operating under a Trade Name, are <u>NOT</u> required to be registered.
