



CIDB Regulations 2022

The Construction Industry Development Board Act 2008, was amended in July 2021, in order to consolidate the legal framework of the construction industry and to empower the CIDB to inter alia facilitate the registration process and improve its operation.

Supporting Regulations to some of those amendments were subsequently made which came into force on 01 October 2021. However, there was need for a further set of Regulations to bring into effect all the remaining amendments to the CIDB Act.

It is to be noted that the Grading of Contractors has now been completely revised. A new and simplified Grading Structure has been introduced to cope with the changing environment and requirements of the construction industry.

The following **NEW** set of supporting Regulations has been made. Those Regulations are effective as from 01 January 2022.
