

Criteria for Registration of Contractors

Grade Designation	Criteria (in MUR)	
	2 No. Highest Value Projects (HVP) (completed within last 5 years)	Average Annual Turnover for Construction Works (over last 5 years)
Large (No Limit) <i>(Previously Grades A+ & A)</i>	1.25 billion per project	300 million
Medium I (Up to MUR 500 million) <i>(Previously Grades B & C)</i>	375 million per project	250 million
Medium II (Up to MUR 200 million) <i>(Previously Grades D, E, F & G)</i>	150 million per project	100 million
Small (Up to MUR 20 million) <i>(Previously Grade H)</i>	2 No. projects of cumulative value at least MUR 800,000	

Note: A Contractor may be granted **Registration**, provided it satisfies **ANY ONE** of the above two criteria, i.e either the **HVP** criterion or the **Average Annual Turnover** criterion.

Criteria for Upgrading of Contractors

Grade Designation	Criteria (in MUR)	
	2 No. Highest Value Projects (HVP) (completed within last 5 years)	Average Annual Turnover for Construction Works (over last 5 years)
From Medium I to Large	300 million per project	150 million
From Medium II to Medium I	150 million per project	75 million
From Small to Medium II	15 million per project	7.5 million

Note: A Contractor may be granted **Upgrading**, provided it satisfies **ANY ONE** of the above two criteria, i.e either the **HVP** criterion or the **Average Annual Turnover** criterion.

Criteria for Registration of Joint Venture Contractors

Where an application has been made by a joint venture contractor, then the Applicant joint venture shall be eligible to obtain the Grade of the highest graded party in that joint venture. (For example. if an application is made by a JV comprising "Medium I" and "Medium II" contractors, then the JV will obtain Grade "Medium I").
