

COMMUNIQUE

Registration of Local Contractors – Grace Period

Local Contractors operating in the construction industry are hereby informed that they have to be duly registered with the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) as per the provisions of the Construction Industry Development Board Act. Registration is mandatory for those undertaking projects above One Million Rupees (Exclusive VAT).

CIDB wishes to inform Local Contractors of the following important measures:

1. Contractors **NOT** registered and carrying works above Rs 1M (Exclusive VAT) are being given a **Grace Period up to 30 June 2021**, to register with the CIDB. Once registered, they will be eligible to participate in bids for projects in accordance with their respective Grades.
2. Registered Local Contractors undertaking works above the value to which their respective Grades entitle them, should apply for upgrading.
