Streamlining of Registration of Contractors

Contractors Operating Without Registration

It has been brought to the attention of CIDB that many contractors are operating in the Construction Industry without being registered as required under the CIDB Act 2008.

In this respect, the CIDB has decided to give a grace period to allow those Contractors to register with the CIDB at latest by 30 June 2021.

The experience acquired by those Contractors would be taken into consideration in determining their grading.

Where a Contractor fails to register by the deadline of 30 June 2021, he would then be operating illegally and would be committing an offence under the CIDB Act.

Contractors in the above situation are kindly invited to register themselves at the earliest so as not to miss the above deadline.

Registration As Contractor In Grade A+

In order to enhance competition in the Construction Industry, CIDB has decided to allow two or more Grade A, Grade B or Grade C Contractors to set up a Joint Venture and obtain a Grade A+ Classification, so as to be eligible to participate in bidding exercise for major infrastructural projects above Rs 1 billion. However, the Joint Venture should necessarily include a Grade A Contractor.

Contractors are invited to seize this opportunity if they wish to obtain a Grade A+ Classification.
